This event is organized by the UNECE Centre of **Excellence on Sustainable Finance for** Infrastructure and Smart Cities (ExSUF) in collaboration with the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE). It is part of the preparatory process for the Ministerial Meeting on Housing and Affordability, to be held on 8 October at the Palais des Nations in Geneva during the 86th session of the Committee on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management.

The event will explore innovative strategies for affordable housing, emphasizing sustainability and energy efficiency. It will address potential funding mechanisms and the role of private investment in promoting eco-friendly housing that is both accessible and financially viable.
